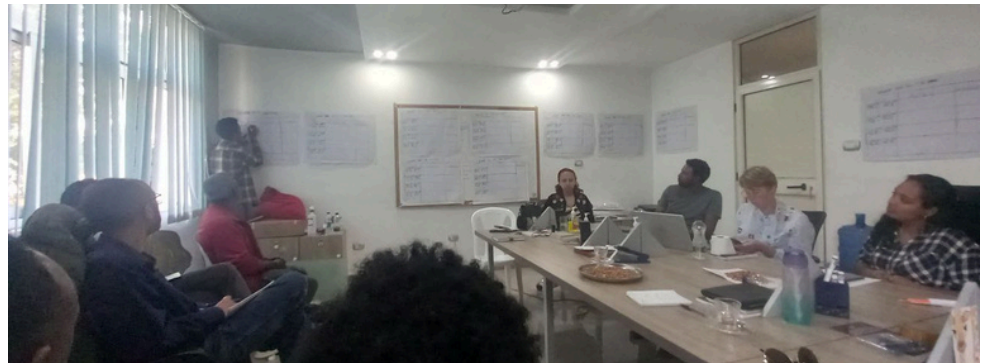


## A New Year Begins... Planning for Impact
