Through our USA partner Christian Assembly Church in Los Angeles, we have received a matching fund of \$ 26,000.00 USD to continue our next phase of the building project. To match this, we held a meeting with our graduates, who were students during the 1980'ies and 1990'ies, and arranged an Associates Event at the building site on October 19th. We are so grateful to our local graduates and associates, who stepped up and matched the grant from a USA partner, and together we raised 3 million ETB. So now we are all set for the next phase, and we are so grateful that the building project is progressing!
