Due to the persecution under the communist regime in the 70's and 80's, the student ministry had to go underground. For the preservation of the ministry among high school students, this part of the ministry was handed over to Scripture Union – Ethiopia (SUE). And ever since there has been a longing for reengagement in the high school ministry area and also a deep gratitude to Scripture Union for their faithful continuation of this ministry.

Since the Vision 2022 Strategic Plan for EvaSUE was developed, we have been working on implementing the 4th strategic priority in the plan: Campus High School Linkage.

Friday, the 6th of December 2024, was therefore a historic day for EvaSUE.
