Abenezer Abel is one of the new nine staff we've been training. Abenezer grew up in the Woleta area of southern Ethiopia. His family was a Christian family. Before he was born, his family had suffered alot during the Derg regime for sharing the gospel. When his mother was pregnant with him, there was an accident with electricity that caused her to have a big medical problem. But through people praying, she became well and that is why they gave Abenezer his name, which means "gift of God." Abenezer's family dedicated all the children in the family (5 boys, 3 girls) for the service and purpose of God.

Abenezer went to University in Bahir Dar and studied mechanical engineering. During his time on campus, he became involved in EvaSUE and became a fellowship leader. He was able to grow as a leader and his passion for seeing people come to Christ grew. He also was involved in a local church and also saw the impact of the gospel and what happened when people were mobilized for mission. He knew this was what he wanted to give his life to.
